

Foster Care



A person must be at least 21 years of age to become a foster parent.

They must complete 33 hours of pre-service training.

Becoming a Foster parent involves 4-6 home visits with the Agency's Foster Care & Adoption Coordinator.

Some of the elements required (but not an inclusive list) are:

--Background checks of all adult members of the household

--Physicals to be completed on all members of the household (child and adults alike)

--Fire Inspection completed on the home

--Well test completed by Health Dept. or signed agreement to use only bottled water
